Information for parents of Year 11 students

In third term each year we ask all students in Years 8 to 11 to undertake the important task of selecting their courses for the following year. It is a time when students need to work closely with their parents/caregivers and teachers to gather accurate, relevant information on which to base decisions about subjects and future directions.

The purpose of this Course Counselling newsletter is to give details of our Course Counselling process for Year 11 students for this year.

AS A PARENT YOU CAN ASSIST BY:

- Reading the Curriculum Guide carefully and encouraging your child to do the same – this can be found online at www.nurihs.sa.edu.au/curriculum.htm
- Exploring the Web Preferences online program for further information about subject choices.
- Working through the practice choice sheet prior to entering information on Web Choices.
- Talk with your child about:
 - Their interests, particularly regarding subjects
 - Their future career and study aspirations
 - Their progress in subjects they are doing this year
 - The subjects on offer for next year
 - Your ideas about their subject choices
- Attending the **Curriculum Information Expo** on **Wednesday 15 August** (see attached sheet)
- Assisting your child to see subject selection as an important process that requires careful consideration
- Encouraging your child to ask questions and seek advice
- Contacting school staff to discuss any issues where you need more information
- Make a course counselling appointment – refer to counselling day information in this letter.

ONLINE SUBJECT SELECTION PROCESS

The following steps outline how to enter your subject preferences online.

1 Internet Access	<p>You will need a computer with an internet connection and a printer.</p> <p>We recommend using Firefox, you may also use Google Chrome or IE 6.0 and above.</p>
2 Log In	<p>Log in to www.selectmysubjects.com.au using:</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Student Access Code: <input type="text" value="NHS student code"/> Password: <input type="text" value="Unique password"/></p>
3 Home Page	<p>To view your subject information click "View Subject Details" at the top right of the screen.</p> <p>To select/change your preferences, click "Add New Preferences" at the top right of the screen.</p>
4 Preference Selection	<p>Select your subjects from the drop down lists, you have 30 minutes to do so.</p> <p>Once complete, click "Proceed".</p> <p>Note: You are not finished yet.</p>
5 Preference Validation	<p>If you are happy with your preferences click "Submit Valid Preferences" which will open your "Preference Receipt".</p> <p>Or if you would like to make changes to your preferences click "Cancel" and this will take you back to the Preference Selection page.</p>
6 Preference Receipt	<p>You can print your "Preference Receipt" by clicking "Open Print View" and clicking "Print Receipt".</p> <p>To continue click "Return to Home Page". If you want to change your preferences, repeat the process by clicking "Add New Preferences", otherwise exit by clicking "Log Out". End of steps.</p>

As part of the course counselling process, we request that you and your daughter/son attend a 15-minute course counselling interview with members of the counselling team on **Tuesday 28 August** in the School's Resource Centre. All Year 11 students are required to attend an interview with a parent/guardian. Trained staff will be available for the counselling interviews for students with a Negotiated Education Plan.

At present, Year 11 students are collecting information about their options for next year. The **Curriculum Guide 2019**, which is available on the NHS website www.nurihs.sa.edu.au, contains information on available courses and on the SACE. Subject descriptions are also available on the online subject selection portal "Web Preferences" www.selectmysubjects.com.au **Please bring the practice subject selection form to the interview** (both sides need to be completed in pencil).

There will be no formal classes for Year 11 students on the counselling day. However, there is the option for students to attend supervised study for the day. Please indicate if your son/daughter will be attending supervised study on the reply slip along with your preferred interview time.
