

The Governing Council is responsible for deciding school uniform policy.

Responsibilities

Parents

- To support the school uniform policy by providing school uniform clothing to their children.
- To communicate suggestions for improvement to the school uniform policy to the Governing Council.

Students

- To support the school uniform policy by wearing school uniform clothing.
- To communicate suggestions for improvement to the school uniform policy to the Governing Council via the SRC.

Home Group Teachers/Year Level Managers/Assistant Principals/Deputy Principal

- To support the school uniform policy by recognising and encouraging students to wear school uniform.
- To communicate suggestions for improvement to the school uniform policy to the Governing Council via staff representatives.
- The Home Group teacher sends letters home for non-compliance of uniform.
- The Year Level Managers, Assistant Principals and Deputy Principal supports the Home Group teachers with student uniform compliance by having students change into loan uniform.

Principal

- To support the school uniform policy.
- To keep the Governing Council informed about issues relating to school uniform.
- To consider written requests for exemptions under grounds indicated in section 3 of the Administrative instructions and guidelines.

Governing Council

- To determine the school uniform policy taking into account the views of students, parents and staff.
- To periodically review the school uniform policy.

Why we have a school uniform

1. Safety and security – Nuriootpa High School students are easily recognisable in uniform both at school and on excursions. Similarly unauthorised persons are more easily noticed if on school grounds.
2. Economy – school uniform clothing is usually more durable than fashion clothes.
3. Dressing appropriately for the occasion – school uniform clothing is appropriate for most student activities.
4. Pride in personal appearance and in being a student at Nuriootpa High School – students, parents, visitors, residents and businesses in the district frequently report on the positive image and presentation of Nuriootpa High School students.
5. Occupational Health and Safety reasons.

School uniform clothing can be purchased from the Uniform Shop located on the school premises.

Agreed Strategies in Response to Students Who Are Not In School Uniform

1. Students will be provided with a loan item if available. Year level Assistant Principal will determine other strategies if required.
 2. Persistent non-compliers will not be able to participate in extra-curricular activities such as sports, music performances, the senior school formal, days and other activities of a similar nature.
 3. Students out of uniform will not be permitted
 - to attend special school assemblies (eg. end of year).
 - on stage at other assemblies to receive awards.
 - to participate in an excursion if school uniform is specified for that excursion.
 - to be photographed for local media publications.
 4. Non- Compliance with school uniform will result in the behaviour management policy being enforced.

Nuriootpa High School Uniform

*Our on-site Uniform Shop stocks all items of clothing except those indicated ****

Junior Polo Shirt -Years 8-10 pale blue with school logo.

Senior Polo shirt -Years 11-12 navy with school logo and 'SENIORS' embroidered below logo

PE Polo - gold and navy with school logo

Buttoned School Shirt - pale blue, long-sleeved and school logo.

Tie - junior navy with pale blue and gold stripes.

Shorts - navy, microfiber with school logo, or stretch poly-cotton with school logo, or chino style.

Chino Long Pants -navy.

Track Pants - navy blue fleecy or microfiber with school logo.

Dress - navy and white check with gold and brown stripe.

Skirt - navy, gold and white plaid

Knitted Jumper- navy, plain v-neck with school logo.

Zip-up Jacket - navy with pockets, school logo and pale blue stripe bands.

Rugby Top - navy with pale blue yoke and stripes with school logo left side.

Hoodie - Navy with pale blue stripe bands and school logo must be worn over the polo shirt

Hat/Cap - Navy cap or bucket hat

***** These following items are by private purchase and not available in the uniform shop***:**

Undershirt - non-hooded navy or white long sleeved top***

Socks - white, navy. ***

Scarf - School Colours***

Stockings -Plain stockings/tights/leggings must cover the entire foot and are to be navy, black, or flesh coloured and worn under the skirt or dress. ***

Shoes - fully enclosed black shoe with low heel appropriate for school wear. Sneakers in black, navy, grey, white or combinations of these colours are appropriate. ***

Special Uniforms – there may be special events that teachers or students wish to have a special uniform e.g. Royal Show or Performance. Approval required from the Principal. ***

The following are not acceptable for school:

denim, non-School Logos, active wear, ugg boots, thongs and open sandals
